SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

General information:

In case of accident or unwellness, seek medical advice immediately (show directions for use or safety data sheet if possible). Remove victim out of the danger area. If accidentally swallowed rinse the mouth with plenty of water (only if the person is conscious) and obtain immediate medical attention. Rinse mouth. Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell. Let 1 glass of water be drunk in little sips (dilution effect).
